Chapter 1: The Ascendant

The precise time on the day of your birth determines your particular Ascendant, also known as your Rising Sign. This was the zodiac sign that was rising over the horizon when you were born. In addition to your Sun and Moon Sign, the Rising Sign reveals very important traits that make up a major part of your personality and your individual approach to life. This is usually the impression you like to make before you really get to know someone; it is your outer personality and image.

Libra Rising:

There is a distinct part of your outer personality that expresses itself very much like a Libra. You are charming, diplomatic, prefer cooperation to competition and people know you for your easy-going manner.

Since this was the sign of the zodiac that was rising over the horizon at your time of birth, the principle of Libra--relating to others--will be integrated into almost every area of life in some way.

Venus is your chart ruler. To discover even more about what's a priority for you, and also, the first impression you make on others, read everything in the chapter on Venus.

Venus in soft aspect to Asc.:

Venus here blesses one with a charming personality and a demeanor that others find very appealing. You can use the powers of subtle persuasion and diplomacy to win other people over. Your physical image is important to you and you have a knack for putting together an attractive package to present to the public.

Uranus in soft aspect to Asc.:

You're a character. At least that's the first impression other people get. Even within the confines of a group, you stand out as unique in some way. When all is said and done, your will is the last word. You have an unpredictable streak in you and other people find you exciting because they never know for sure what you'll do or say next.

Chapter 2: The Sun

The placement of the Sun in your chart will show you how (the sign) and in which area of life (the house) tremendous potential exists for you. Here is where you want to be successful. The Sun cannot be ignored. We must meet and deal with the area of life that the Sun shines on in our chart in order to find ultimate fulfillment. Everything revolves around the Sun. When you master whatever issues the Sun points to, then other areas of life will proceed in a more balanced and satisfactory manner. The Sun also represents: your own will, major goals, the father, men in your life, children, creativity, and the real inner you.

Sun in Gemini:

Clever, social, and communicative, your general approach to life is light hearted. You can be somewhat hard to pin down because you have a wonderful natural curiosity about life. You prefer to know at least a little bit about everything. The restless nature of Gemini is quite conducive to your preference for a wide variety of experiences and mental pursuits. This is the sign of communication in all of its various forms, whether verbal, written, or just learning for the joy of it. You like sharing what you have learned with others, and the latest news and even gossip has a hard time sneaking by you.

Sun in 8th house:

Chapter 3: The Moon

Whenever insecurities arise and our feelings become involved, we tend to bring the traits (the sign) of our Moon into play. The Moon is like our security blanket. Moon in Virgo:

This is a good placement for those who enjoy crafts, as it fulfills your need to feel like you are doing something constructive while at the same time using your natural talent for attention to details.

You may be health oriented also, but the Moon in Virgo can turn into hypochondria if the tendency to worry gets out of hand.

Your emotional need for perfection can drive people who don't understand it (as well as you) to distraction if it becomes obsessive.

Too much chaos and clutter can actually make you feel depressed. When you're feeling down, hope lies in getting busy doing something creative or useful such as housework, crafts, cooking, or anything else that employs your ability to create order out of confusion.

Moon in 11th house:

You need groups of people and the support that friends and acquaintances offer. At the same time, you have a need to maintain an emotional distance so that your independence is kept intact, as there is a natural inclination toward yielding to the desires of the "group mind." Group associations often lack permanence depending upon how strong your individual desire for freedom is.

Women in general may have some important bearing on the realization of your

Personal life aspirations and lofty ideals are subject to waxing and waning enthusiasm on your part. Try giving yourself little pep talks when you're getting off track.

Mercury in soft aspect to Moon:

You're sensitive, responsive, and versatile. People find it easy to share their thoughts with you because you're a good listener.

Any negative emotional states you find yourself immersed in can be countered through the use of thinking and logic. You can mentally talk yourself out of a bad mood. You are someone who can be appealed to through a logical mental approach.

Venus Conjunct or in hard aspect to Moon:

Other people find you to be a soft touch. There is a gullible side to you that will toughen up as you mature.

You also like to indulge yourself in immediate gratification and to heck with disagreeable duties; they can wait 'til later.

Mars in soft aspect to Moon:

You can have a very quick temper, and your emotions can be highly charged but fleeting. You don't like to hold grudges. You'd rather deal with it at the time and get on with life.

When you're feeling good about yourself, you have a sparkle and vivaciousness that others enjoy being around.

Chapter 4: Mercury

Mercury is the planet of communication. It tells us about how we think and talk. You can gain insight into your mode of gathering, processing and transmitting information from Mercury's placement in your chart. Mercury also represents: transportation, the five senses, youth, reading, and writing.

Mercury in Taurus:

You learn by experience and steady application. You prefer dealing with hard facts and whatever you learn you do not easily forget.

You express yourself verbally in a manner that is often slow and measured, and you may have a voice that is attractive to others.

Voluntary change doesn't come naturally to you, and sometimes rigid thought patterns and opinions can be difficult to shift.

Mercury in 8th house:

Your thinking can undergo a complete change and you can use the power of the mind and the words you speak to change your world. Spoken affirmations carry weight with this placement. Keep them positive.

Mars Conjunct or in hard aspect to Mercury:

If you don't make a habit of second guessing yourself, this aspect can boost your intuition if you're willing to trust it.

You are challenged to use the power of communication to enhance, rather than detract from your own best interest.

Jupiter Conjunct or in hard aspect to Mercury:

You may experience an inner conflict at times between acting on logic and acting on pure faith.

You express yourself well, but there is sometimes a tendency to be overly verbose due to the fact that you doubt your own ability to get your point across satisfactorily. People do understand more of what you say than you may think they do.

Really grasping what you hear can be challenging for you because your mind often likes to race ahead of the subject at hand.

Uranus Conjunct or in hard aspect to Mercury:

Do you ever enjoy seeing the shocked looks you get from others when you blurt out something totally off the wall? You just may, with the planet of rebelliousness meeting your communication planet. Or, it's quite possible that this manifests simply as a lack of tact, which is not necessarily intended on your part.

You can excel at anything where verbal skills and intelligence are necessary, although you may have to develop them.

Chapter 5: Venus

Venus is the planet of relating to others, and thus is associated with love, attraction and socializing. In a male's chart, Venus can provide clues about traits he finds attractive in females. In a female's chart, it reveals something about how she relates to males. Venus is also the planet of material goodies and sensual delights in all of their various forms. Venus also represents: money, harmonious conditions, pleasurable activities, beauty, and the arts.

Venus in Gemini:

Friendly, social and verbally charming, you love light-hearted conversation and a variety of social contacts. Gemini's love of variety has given this placement a reputation for fickleness. See how a butterfly flits from flower to flower? That's often the Venus in Gemini approach. Your genuine interest in other people makes you seem to be flirtatious to those who don't understand your need for social contact. However, even though this placement may bring numerous relationships, you are quite capable of settling down when you find someone who can match your need for mental stimulation and your enjoyment of the diversity of life.

Venus in 8th house:

Chapter 6: Mars

Mars is our planet of action, energy output, motivation, and instinctive biological drives. It shows how and in which area of life you are willing to put forth a lot of effort. Mars' energy is quick, impulsive, and survival oriented. In a male's chart, Mars reveals something about how he relates to females. In a female's chart, Mars can provide clues about the traits she finds attractive in males. Mars also represents: competitive situations, conflicts, accidents, and sexual energies.

Mars in Taurus:

Mars in 8th house:

Jupiter Conjunct or in hard aspect to Mars:

You have a lot of drive which, ideally, you can learn to control and focus on constructive goals. In this case you can get a lot accomplished.

Chapter 7: Jupiter

Jupiter is the planet of expansion and taking things beyond normal limits. It shows us where the universe allows us to indulge ourselves, and often we find that wherever it is in the chart is where things work out in our favor eventually. Some call this luck. Jupiter also represents: faith, ideas about God, abstract

thinking, high ideals, and abundance.

Jupiter in Taurus:

Even though you may have a very practical approach toward money and possessions, there is still a part of you that can be quite generous. You have a natural ability to make money and provide for your own financial security. Many of the blessings of life arrive in the form of money and material gifts. Objects of beauty give you great pleasure.

This placement expands all of the Taurus traits and can make you very stubborn, sensation oriented, and bound to certain habits and routines. Singing talent or the ability to project your voice may also be present.

Jupiter in 8th house:

Other people's money can be fortunate for you. Most likely this will be through an inheritance of some sort, although it's hard to say how much.

This placement indicates that something about your personal belief system and/or your ideas about God will undergo a drastic change.

Sex and emotional expression is important to you and you will have at least one deeply intimate bonding experience with another person.

The world of metaphysics can be beneficial for you. You can combine traditional religious ideas with supernatural concepts.

Uranus Conjunct or in hard aspect to Jupiter:

This aspect often describes the law-abiding citizen who wants to do what is right and who can even be a bit dictatorial from time to time. At the same time you often experience an inner urge to break free from orthodox viewpoints and to question the laws of the land. This is your dilemma. You can go overboard in either direction. Can you move ahead and admit you don't have all the answers? Can you break with old traditions and still not break the law? If you can find this exciting, you're ahead of the game.

Chapter 8: Saturn

Saturn is our planet of restriction and discipline. It shows us where we may feel inadequate in some way, and thus we take this area of life very seriously because

we want to perfect ourselves. Saturn also represents: life lessons to be learned, trials and tests, a strong sense of duty, and bringing ideas into material form.

Saturn in Cancer:

Neptune Conjunct or in hard aspect to Saturn:

The "real" world sometimes becomes too much to bear and a part of you is strongly attracted to those who claim to hold the true way to enlightenment and inner peace. The problem is, you tend to have many doubts about that which is not readily apparent via the five senses.

The positive side of this aspect is that it instills an ability to take that which can be imagined and bring it into solid form. Art, music, and other creative endeavors can provide a satisfactory means for rising above the crassness of everyday existence and entering a more utopian environment, even if you must create it yourself.

Chapter 9: Uranus

Uranus in 4th house:

Chapter 10: Neptune

Neptune in 10th house:

Chapter 11: Pluto

Pluto is a planet that brings with it transformation. Something about the area of life that it points to will undergo a complete change. Read the house placement for Pluto in your chart. It shows you an area of life where this planet has a more personal influence.

Pluto in 9th house:

Anything connected to long distance travel or foreign people can become the catalyst for a major lifestyle change.

Your personal belief system, especially that which encompasses either philosophical and religious ideas, will be transformed completely. This is an area of life that you have strong feelings about. Whatever your beliefs are, you tend to hang onto them until the bitter end. However, once you decide to change your thinking on a particular issue, you rarely question the decision.

Chapter 12: Elements, the North Node, and the Midheaven

In this section of the report we interpret the following astrological influences: the Moon's North Node, the MC (the 10th house cusp or Midheaven) and also a preponderance of an astrological element. A "preponderance" occurs when 4 or more planets or the Ascendant is in that element: fire, earth, air, or water. Many people do not have a heavy emphasis of a particular element so not everyone will have an interpretation of an element emphasis.

If the individual chart has aspects to the MC, these will reveal certain career options and potentials for your consideration.

The North Node is an important pointer along the pathway of life. You'll have to be willing to stretch yourself and move away from familiar patterns in order to meet the challenge of the North Node. Great rewards will be reaped in the form of personal growth and reaching your potential goals. The North Node sign will suggest an approach to the area of life represented by its house position.

North Node in Capricorn:

Incorporating the following traits into your life will make it easier in the long run to attain goals.

The best way to describe this principle is to imagine a bird having to leave its nest for the first time. It is extremely challenging, but it's the only way to really learn to fly.

Four or more Earth Signs

Ruler of 2nd house in 9th:
