# INTRODUCTION

This astrological portrait of your child is intended to give you insight into her unique gifts and challenges. Much of a child's behavior which may puzzle or stymie her parents are quite normal, common "developmental stages" of childhood, and there are a number of fine books available on the subject which illuminate the predictable stages that children experience as they unfold. In addition to the universal patterns, each child is an individual with particular qualities, potentials, and needs, and an understanding of these can help you parent your child more wisely and effectively. Acceptance and appreciation for a child's basic nature, and an awareness of the places where there might be stress or difficulties for your child, can be important allies in your parenting.

You will find that the interpretation of your child's chart is written in simple language, uncluttered by astrological jargon. If a statement appears to contradict another statement, then she exhibits these opposite qualities at different times in her life. For example, a statement that she is highly sociable and gregarious and a statement that you prefer solitude seemingly contradict each other; this means that she vacillates, and needs both sociability and solitude at different times.

# ASCENDANT

The RISING SIGN in the birthchart (also known as the Ascendant) shows how this child faces life, her basic attitude or stance toward the world, the way she comes across, and how she appears to others.

## *Gemini Rising:*

Alyssa Marie is inclined to be slight of build, with a quick, restless, wiry body that seems to be in constant motion. Playful, alert, intelligent, and tremendously curious and inquisitive, she is eager to get out and about, to meet people, and to interact with the world as much as possible. She has a light, frivolous side. She loves to play, and she will always have a childlike eagerness to learn new things or to try something "just for the experience." She can easily be distracted from something you do not wish her to have by showing her something new or introducing a different idea to her. She loves surprises, guessing games, quizzes, and the like. She tends to bounce from one activity to the next and she can be exhausting to keep pace with. She also changes her mind with amazing frequency. You may need to insist that she follows through or finishes one thing before moving on to the next.

Language and communication are her primary mode of self-expression, and in her later years she is likely to be a vivacious and witty conversationalist, a salesperson, spokesperson, interviewer, or teacher. Her gift for gab can be somewhat annoying to a harried parent, unless you are equally social and verbal and enjoy having a running conversation throughout the day.

She is more mental than physical, and she may not want to attend to the needs of her physical body. She tends to eat lightly and she would probably eat on the run if you would let her. She also does not usually want to give in to sleep either, since she is naturally a very alert and awake person.

This is a child that can be reasoned with at a young age. She is logical and

intellectual and you must appeal to her reason rather than her emotions in order to get your point across. She also has a very comic side to her and is likely to delight you with her imitations and mimicry. Wit and humor are two ways she responds to any situation.

*Asc. Sextile Moon:*

Alyssa Marie makes friends a second family, and it's very important to her to feel a sense of belonging and community, and to be an accepted part of a group. She instinctively understands what it takes to get along, how to treat people, and what others want and need. At times she is apt to go along with the crowd because she would rather not create any friction, both with family and with peers. She has a natural sensitivity that sometimes makes her a bit too yielding.

*Asc. Square Mercury:*

Quick-witted and nimble in both mind and body, Alyssa Marie is apt to be rather restless and to need to move about, talk and ask questions, and experience as much of the world as she can. She may appear nervous or unsettled at times. She is also vociferous about her ideas and opinions, and she is more inclined to speak out than to listen receptively to what others have to say.

*Asc. Trine Venus:*

Alyssa Marie's personal appeal, charm, and gracious manners usually make a highly favorable first impression on others, and many doors open for her simply because of her agreeable personality. She has a gift for making other people comfortable and at ease with her. She does not like to argue or create discord, preferring to overlook problems or differences that arise between herself and others. Affection and harmony are more important to her than winning or defeating someone else.

*Asc. Trine Mars:*

Alyssa Marie is inclined to act first and think later. She has little patience for people who are less decisive than she is, and she is apt to ignore or run over children who are slower and less self-assured. It is not that she is unkind, just very energetic.

Alyssa Marie is not afraid to take a stand or to go it alone if she has to.

## SUN

The SUN in the birthchart represents who this child is at heart, her primary thrust in life, and what path she needs to follow in order to fulfill herself as a unique individual. It indicates who she is inside rather than the way she appears (which is shown more clearly by the Rising Sign).

*Sun in Aries:*

At heart, Alyssa Marie has a strong need to act boldly and vigorously in living her life according to her own standards (and no one else's!). She has a strong competitive drive, thrives on challenge, and needs to be first in some way. It is hard for her to accept a secondary position, as she prefers either to lead or to go off alone and do her own thing. She does not compromise or make concessions easily.

Enthusiasm, initiative, self-reliance, courage, and an eager, positive attitude toward life are her strong points. Learning to direct her abundant energy into productive channels will be a challenge for her and for her parents. She requires a lot of physical activities and outlets; otherwise, she is likely to become very frustrated and disruptive at times. Athletics are a natural arena for her, but her drive may just as easily be directed into an intellectual sphere, in which case she will strive to be at the top of her class. Being the very best and triumphing over challenges is what she is aiming for, and she takes her successes or failures very much to heart. She needs to have some area in which she excels.

She will need to be encouraged to finish what she starts, to follow through, and to develop stamina and persistence, because sometimes she will enthusiastically begin a project only to drop it once the initial rush of excitement wanes.

She has a great sense of the drama of Good and Evil. The stories of Robin

Hood, the Knights of the Round Table, or other, more modern versions of the Brave and Noble Hero doing battle with Evil Forces, have a powerful appeal for her.

She admires valor and decisive action, can be quite aggressive, and is not averse to a good fight. As an adult she is likely to fight for what she believes in.

She can be a difficult child to raise, especially if compliance, obedience, and submissiveness to parental authority are strongly emphasized in her home. She fiercely resists conforming to others ideas and ways. Also, she tends to be selfish in an unthinking, unintentional way. She is often so intent on carrying out her own desires that she is oblivious to how she affects other people. Unless other factors in her chart (such as the moon sign or the rising sign, or important planetary configuration) indicate otherwise, she may be difficult to socialize.

Her manners and her awareness of other people's needs and feelings may be underdeveloped. She will need to be reminded (gently and often) to take others into account.

*Sun in 11th house:*

Alyssa Marie's social world and friendships are extremely important to her. She shines in groups and in cooperative endeavors and is apt to feel at loose ends when left to her own devices. For instance, growing up in a fairly remote rural setting might be very nourishing and inspiring for some children, but for her it is limiting and probably boring. Teams, clubs, and other groups which she and her peers can join are her cup of tea.

*Sun Conjunct Uranus:*

Alyssa Marie has an independent, rebellious, and restless side that can be disruptive at times. She is likely to be contrary, to constantly question authority, and to resist rules of conduct imposed by others. Certainly she will chaff at restrictions and restraints, and she resents being dictated to.

Freedom is very important to her. She also likes to liven things up when they become too dull, and she is not adverse to creating controversy or taking an unconventional stance. She likes being unique, doing things in her own original or offbeat way, and there is a touch of the creative genius in her.

### *Sun Square Jupiter:*

Optimism, positive expectations, and exuberance Alyssa Marie has in abundance, but she tends to go to excesses with her enthusiasm of the moment. She can be wasteful, extravagant, and careless with her resources and energy. She likes to have a good time and to go all-out, but she tends to overdo. She does have a buoyant, resilient spirit and a philosophical bent that enables her to learn from all of her experiences and to emerge with fresh hope, even from a very difficult situation.

### *Sun Square Pluto:*

Alyssa Marie seems to need to drive and push herself as far as she can. Her desire to be great or to prove herself compels her to go to extremes. Willful and quietly persistent, she cannot easily be swayed from her purposes, and she may ignore or run over others' aims if they interfere with her own. She sometimes has trouble accepting authority or outside guidance.

She may also show a pronounced interest in death, afterlife, or the hidden, mysterious aspects of life.

## **MERCURY**

MERCURY represents thinking and reasoning processes, the way your child's mind works, her intellectual inclinations and way of communicating ideas.

### *Mercury in Pisces:*

Alyssa Marie's mind is intuitive and imaginative rather than strictly logical. More of an artist or poet than a scientist, she daydreams a lot, and it may be hard for her to articulate what she perceives and thinks about. Dry technical subjects hold no appeal for her.

### *Mercury in 10th house:*



Education is extremely important to Alyssa Marie, because she's ambitious and will be drawn to an intellectual career, one that involves presenting ideas and concepts. She may start planning her college curriculum in elementary school! Having an elder who takes a special interest in her education will make a significant impact on her life.

*Mercury Trine Saturn:*

Alyssa Marie's ability to concentrate, to organize and structure her work, and to think in clear, specific, practical terms makes her a successful student and a productive worker. She has sound judgment and is impartial and unemotional when making decisions. She likes to learn practical or technical skills, not just intellectual or theoretical knowledge.

## MOON

The MOON in the birthchart indicates how she deals with and expresses feelings, how she experiences the world on an emotional, feeling, non-verbal level, what her emotional needs are, and what she needs to feel secure, comfortable and at ease.

*Moon in Aries:*

High spirited and lively, this child needs action and she loves to be moving. She is attracted to anything with speed and energy, and to anything that involves challenge or competition (like running a race). She does things quickly, sometimes carelessly, and she hates to wait for anything. She can be very temperamental and impatient if the pace is too slow, and she gets frustrated with herself when she cannot master a task right away. She wants very much to be independent. She also wants very much to win, to be the first, to be the best.

She can be bossy and domineering, is something of a fighter, and will passionately defend the people she loves or the causes she believes in.

She is inclined to sudden bursts of anger or irritability, especially when

overstimulated by her environment (too much noise and excitement, television, etc.), or confined for too long (as in a long car ride). Outdoor activity and physical play is very essential.

She may be a fitful, restless sleeper or adamantly resist going to bed at night, especially in her youngest years.

Emotionally she may seem quite self-sufficient, as she dislikes depending on others' help. Sometimes she acts angry or upset, when underneath she is really feeling afraid or hurt or when she is needing comfort or reassurance. You may have to see past her "fireworks display" and probe a little to understand what is really going on with her.

Sometimes she simply insists on "doing her own thing" and she may not fit in or conform.

*Moon in 11th house:*

Alyssa Marie feels at home when she belongs to a group, a club, or a team of some sort--an organization that serves as a second family. She thrives on group activities--such as a church youth club or a scout troop--in which she can develop long-term friendships. Such involvements will serve her best if they emphasize cooperation, support, belonging, and acceptance rather than competition.

*Moon Opposition Mars:*

Alyssa Marie is rather short-tempered and prone to impulsive actions based on emotion and the heat of the moment, which she will regret later when she is in a calmer mood.

She is a go-getter and not the docile, well-behaved, submissive type at all. She can be very combative and defiant at times, also.

*Moon Sextile Venus:*

Alyssa Marie has an affectionate, loving disposition, and she needs people and emotional closeness very much. She is inclined to depend on her friends and loved ones, and to be very supportive and devoted to them in return. She likes to make people comfortable and at ease. Home will always be very

important to her.

## VENUS

VENUS represents the way your child gives and receives affection, makes friends, and socializes. It also indicates artistic or creative inclinations.

### *Venus in Aquarius:*

Alyssa Marie likes to have a variety of friends and is attracted to people who are unusual or different from her in some way. She is very fair and dislikes prejudice. She will especially enjoy making friends in clubs or organizations that have some common interest, ideal, or goal as their focus.

### *Venus in 9th house:*

Alyssa Marie has a broadminded view of love and friendship. When she is older she may want to travel the world, making friends and enjoying other cultures. "The family of man" makes a lot of sense to her and accords with her desire for harmony between people. Prejudice or the denigration of foreign customs and beliefs is utterly abhorrent to her.

### *Venus Square Saturn:*

Alyssa Marie needs much reassurance that she is wanted, valued, and worthy of love; otherwise, she is inclined to feel alienated and afraid to trust people. Though she very much wants friends, it may be hard for her to get close to people. She is likely to have just a few close friends that she keeps for a long time, and to be ill-at-ease in social situations or when meeting new people.

### *Venus Trine Mars:*

Alyssa Marie has a great appreciation for beauty, and she also has the drive to create or make art. There is much warmth and love within her that she needs to find ways to express and share with others.

# MARS

MARS represents your child's drive, ambition, will, energy level, and ability to assert herself.

*Mars in Libra:*

Alyssa Marie hesitates to act decisively and assertively unless she has the support and approval of others. Sometimes she is very pushy or argumentative in her effort to get others to agree with her and give her the go-ahead.

*Mars in 5th house:*

Alyssa Marie loves rough, high-action, and high-energy games and entertainments. She plays hard and plays to win. However, she won't work hard at a project that lacks an element of playfulness and fun. She has a rambunctious, daring, reckless streak.

# JUPITER

JUPITER in the birth chart reveals the child's future aspirations, and how she seeks to grow and improve herself. It also indicates areas of natural confidence, success, or "luck."

*Jupiter in Cancer:*

Family and continuity with the past are very important to Alyssa Marie, and no matter what her aspirations, she will never willingly grow away from her people. She will want to learn as much as possible about her family tree, her origins and ancestors. Being a part of an ongoing tradition--part of a tribe, so to speak--gives her confidence and strength. Visiting the homes of distant relatives would delight her.

Even though she's devoted to her family, her emotional generosity and sympathies extend beyond her immediate circle. She wants everyone to be "family," and will gladly accept schoolmates, camp buddies, and friends as such. Her nurturing, protective feelings are strong and she's very caring toward other children (especially younger ones) and toward pets--indeed, toward anyone in need of support.

*Jupiter in 1st house:*

Alyssa Marie tends to be fortunate because of the positive first impression she makes on both other children and adults. Instinctively she puts her best foot forward, and comes across as a confident, open person who can afford to be generous to others. She'll want to participate in a lot of extracurricular activities, and be well known and popular at school and in the community. She could be "a big fish in a small pond" too.

*Jupiter Opposition Pluto:*

Alyssa Marie is quite a zealot (at least about certain things) and she'll be passionately dedicated to her causes and beliefs. She seeks to grow through intensity and destroying perceived limitations. Especially in youth, she may be pushy and self-righteous - or just very sure of her convictions.

*Jupiter Square Uranus:*

Alyssa Marie seeks to grow through total freedom. Spontaneous, restless, and eager, she will immediately say yes to almost any festive plan or adventure presented. She loves to have complete freedom to explore and decide for herself what she thinks, believes, and what makes her happy. Play will be an important part of her life, even as an adult.

## **SATURN**

The position of SATURN in your child's birth chart indicates the areas in which she is especially insecure, about which she is most serious, and/or in which she works hardest or is hardest on herself. It also reveals those

weaknesses which, through effort, may become her greatest strengths.

*Saturn in Scorpio:*

Any struggles, fears, or troublesome feelings that Alyssa Marie encounters are apt to be kept to herself, but perceptive parents and other caregivers can detect them--usually from her brooding silences or her withdrawal from the social life of the family. This secretiveness may work against her by intensifying her turmoil. Difficult unexpressed emotions, such as jealousy over the birth of a new sibling or anger at a parent, can grow out of all proportion. At times, therefore, she'll feel misunderstood: "Nobody really knows me." The truth is that it can be hard to get to know her, because she doesn't readily trust others.

If she has even one confidante--a parent, an aunt or uncle, or another trustworthy adult who will not judge, shame, or "thou-shalt-not" her feelings--it will go a long way toward diffusing her tensions. If not, she is likely to suffer from guilt for her strong, but essentially normal, emotions and reactions.

*Saturn in 6th house:*

Building up Alyssa Marie's physical health and stamina, through careful attention to nutrition and balancing activity with rest, is important. So is instilling confidence in her health and body, because even when she's quite robust she tends toward hypochondria. Caregivers should be warm and reassuring when she comes to them with her "boo-boos" and tummy aches--without making too much of them. She really picks up on others' anxieties about her health, and she may also fear doctors, dentists, or other health professionals.

## MOON'S NODES

The Lunar Nodes are points formed by the moon's orbit around the Earth intersecting with the Earth's path around the Sun. These sensitive "power points" in our child's chart give vital information about those areas of life experience that she will instinctively be drawn to in order to fulfill her life purposes, as well as qualities she needs to develop and express in order to do so. They show where she can be most successful as she unfolds her natural talent

*North Node in 5th House in Libra:*

Alyssa Marie's life purpose is best served by tapping into her own unique style and creative genius, whatever form that takes. She needs to dramatize, to take center stage in her own life. The joy and magic of creative self expression happens when she gives herself permission to do it her way, rather than needing her peers' cooperation or approval. Because she's meant to bring forth something original and unique, she can't afford to mold herself to others' expectations or tastes. She needs to be her own person and develop her personal will. The things she will do best and most successfully will all have an element of play and spontaneity. Those things that give her the most pleasure will also be her best work.

The qualities Alyssa Marie needs in order to succeed in this endeavor are harmony, balance, and learning to appreciate opposing viewpoints. Encourage her not to go to extremes, but to find middle ground.

## **GENERATIONAL INFLUENCES**

The slow-moving planets Uranus, Neptune, and Pluto represent the ideals, changes, and impulses of an entire generation. While the descriptions below may or may not describe your child as an individual, they will tell you about the climate of the times and the underlying issues and challenges of your child's age group.

For instance, when Neptune (which represents one's spiritual ideals, dreams, aspirations, fantasies and illusions) passed through the egalitarian and harmony-loving sign of Libra (from 1943-1957), the children who would grow into the "flower children," hippies, and supporters of the peace movement were born. Not every person born during that time became a hippie or identified themselves with the peace movement, but certainly they were affected by the feeling-tone and ideals of their age group and the times they grew up in. Thus, the following information is intended to give you insight into the important motifs and issues of your child's generation.

URANUS indicates where the impulse for change, innovation, liberation from the past, and experimentation with new forms is the strongest. It is where the status quo is disrupted or uprooted to make way for something new. Sudden inspiration and invention are also represented by Uranus.

*Uranus in Aries:*

FREEDOM for the individual is of utmost importance to this age group. They are some of the most extreme when it comes to following their own inner spark as opposed to adhering to the rules or guidelines imposed by outside authority. They are infused with a powerful spirit of adventurous freedom, self reliance, and revolution, and are in no way passive if their personal freedoms are impinged upon. Many will be seen as incendiary troublemakers.

*Uranus in 11th house:*

Alyssa Marie's collection of friends is apt to be lively, unusual, and varied because she enjoys mixing incongruous elements and experimenting socially. Even if she appears conservative or "mainstream" herself, she is drawn to others who are not. Tolerance for differences, acceptance of extremes, and investigating social customs and cultures quite divergent from her own is important to her. Prejudice and social inequalities rankle her.

*Uranus Square Pluto:*

Born during a period of massive change and disruption in the world, Alyssa Marie is part of a group of souls destined to undergo radical severance from many of the old ways of life. Because of this, many of them will hold tightly to whatever security they can find, and be quite resistant to change in their worlds. Some, however, will be deeply iconoclastic and instigators of further transformation of the society they are a part of.

NEPTUNE represents the quest for the ideal, the dream, for something more sublime. The sign it is passing through at the time of one's birth colors one's spiritual aspirations and ideals, and also indicates where the desire to escape reality, to fantasize, deceive oneself, and become lost in illusion is the strongest.



### *Neptune in Pisces:*

Profoundly mystical forces are washing over the collective psyche of this group. The life of the soul becomes paramount. Water also becomes a primary concern. Healing waters, fountains, and springs with supernatural powers, as well as being "washed" with the Holy Spirit may play important roles.

### *Neptune in 10th house:*

This child projects much of her idealism onto heroes or people in her life who are mentors, guides, or father figures. She's apt to have her father on a pedestal whether he is present in her life or not, or she may be on a spiritual quest for the ideal father. What she's really seeking is inner direction and it would be helpful to encourage her to listen to her own inner knowing and truth, and to find her own answers.

PLUTO in the birth chart indicates a process of deep change, transformation, and renewal, often through destruction or confrontation with darkness. This is a process that takes place in society as well as in individuals. Pluto's position in the birth chart shows where one is compulsive, extreme, or learning key life lessons.

### *Pluto in Capricorn:*

Those born during these years (2008-2023) struggle to transform corruption, greed, and the control of power and natural resources in the world around them. Large, impersonal institutions and the heavy handed authoritarianism that breaks them up will be challenged by these children as they grow up. They will be profoundly influenced by witnessing the way power is wielded by their fathers and other authorities they encounter. Cynicism and upheaval may result if integrity, wisdom, and a positive use of masculine strength is not modeled for these children.

### *Pluto in 8th house:*

This is a child that is drawn to intense experience. She has a natural resilience and does not avoid things that other people find frightening, ugly, or

dark. As a child she may enjoy thrillers or horror movies, or ask a lot of questions about death. As an adult, she may be drawn to professions that involve handling crisis, emergencies, or life and death situations.
