

INTRODUCTION

The Sun is in Taurus

Your pet Kimber loves his routine and comforts. This critter needs a soothing environment rather than excitement. If you are happy with a cuddly pet then Kimber is your ideal companion. If you live in a busy household then you need to make sure that Kimber's routine is not disrupted, as he likes to feel that there is a familiar pattern to the household routine. Kimber is a solid presence in the household, and may actually be of solid build, particularly around his neck.
