

# INTRODUCTION

Most of the astronomers in ancient history, in the middle ages and in Renaissance period were also astrologers. Most of them were maths professors and experts in Judicial Astrology; they were the ones who found out algebra, geometry, trigonometry and higher maths. They were the Judicial astrologers who accepted that astrology was the predecessor of astronomy and that the transits of the celestial bodies had influences on the life on Earth.

According to ancient scholars, astrology is the art of comprehending the humanity and getting in contact with the Divinity. In the third chapter of his Tetrabiblos, Ptolemy states that this discipline brings joy, happiness and satisfaction and also helps us understand the connection between the humane and divine things.

The Sicilian astrologer Maternus Firmicus, one of the most important figures of Hellenistic Astrology period, suggested learning and practicing astrology also feeds worshiping the Divine One. In his Mathesis, he argued that the heaven was divine and astrology encouraged divine worship. He supposed that the planets were the forces which caused our experiences on Earth. According to Firmicus a good astrologer should keep away from politics, avoid trouble, have a good and permanent reputation, should be honest, should not act greedily, should not humiliate those who have some faults but rather encourage them to behave well, should be very careful in his predictions and act ethically and should learn and understand astrology so well that he could give valid answers to any questions he receive.

Traditional Astrology's basic approach is based on the view that astrology is an art of prediction. It assumes that Cosmos is organized by the Divine Intellect (God) and the seven planets are the manifestation of God on Earth and the causes of the changes in cosmos. It is aware of the freedom of choice which we may define as Partial Will but makes us realise that we have made choices which were already made and the limitations that were determined by an Higher Mind, that is the Total Will (God's will).

Astrology is a Hermetic Science or a Divine Knowledge which helps us understand the operational laws of the sky or the cosmos through observation through a geocentric view. These are the laws which also rule us. Through realising the operating rules of the sky, we reach what is beyond it.

All analysis we make on each chart reminds us our place in the universe and the perfection of the operating system we are in. What we call as "accident" in astrology is not just a simple accident or coincidence but a planned and detailed plan. The word "accident" here indicates the people and the events that the native meets in his life, without his own will; it does not indicate a pure

luck.

Traditional astrology techniques also give us the chance to make character analysis as well as Modern Astrology. It helps us interpret the native's spiritual attributes and his karmic purposes. But it is not limited with these. It sets up the rules for delineation and prediction. It predicts the general course of the life; first divides the life into long periods of time and then divides each part into smaller periods for a better analysis. In practice, it follows an approach from the whole to the part.

Medieval Astrology techniques give us the ability to describe the objective reality that the native experiences, to identify his primary motivations and predict all aspects of his life including marriage, children, profession, finances, health, family and spiritual tendencies. So, when we study on a chart we gain the ability to describe the objective realities of the native's life and to predict his life events.

## THE ASCENDANT OR RISING SIGN

The starting point to a chart reading is the Ascendant (ASC) which is also called the Rising Sign. The ASC is the meeting point of the heaven and earth. The delineation of the chart starts with determining the native's primary motivation.

Leo Rising:

Matthew's primary purpose is to gain power and reputation. He attracts attention by his authoritative and influential personality. Matthew is self-confident, decisive, impressive and lively. He does not want changing conditions.

Matthew is a very talented organiser. On Matthew's side, he may be stubborn, conceit and arrogant. He is friendly, social, self-confident, self-assured and extroverted but he may also be arrogant, keen on status, wiseacre and likes being pampered. He may be a good manager due to his ability in decision making; he is a natural leader and organisor. Matthew takes other people under his auspices and very generous to them.

### PRIMARY MOTIVATION: RULER OF THE ASC IN HOUSE

The ruler of the ASC and its House Placement: Planet which is the ruler of the ASC shows where and in which areas of life of the native wants to realise its primary motivations.

Ruler of Asc in 1st house

## ELEMENTS OF THE SIGN ON THE ASCENDANT

The element of the sign at the cusp of the 1st house (ASC degree) is very important. It indicates where the native is focused.

FIRE (Aries, Leo, Sagittarius): If there is a fire sign at ASC, the native is active and energetic. He is in search of freedom and in need of power. He strives for gaining a reputation. He is extroverted, enthusiastic, adventurist, strong-willed, eager passionate and brave; he is also in need to manifest and prove himself. He is also a little bit impatient and bossy.

EARTH (Taurus, Vrgo, Capricorn): If an earth sign is at ASC, the native is in search of material and physical security. He is rational, reasonable, realistic, careful and conservative as nature. He is also hardworking. He is sometimes over materialistic, not quite sociable and introverted.

AIR (Gemini, Libra, Aquarius): If an Ascendantair sign is at ASC, the native is in search of freedom and motion. His primary needs are communication and exchange of information. He is in need of intellectual stimulation; he is also quite social and enterprising. He likes being with others. He observes what is around and senses quickly. He likes learning as he is quite curious. He wants to know everything that takes place around.

WATER (Cancer, Scorpio, Pisces): If a water sign is at ASC, then the native is in need of emotional security. He is sensitive, passive, deep, scrupulous, imaginative and intuitive. His inner world and dreams are quite active. He is inclined to spiritual subjects and he may feel the emotions of others. He is passive and receptive. He prefers being in harmony with others. His emotional needs are quite deep.

Ascendant is in Leo (Fire)

# GENDER OF THE SIGN ON THE ASCENDANT

The gender of the sign on Ascendant shows the characteristics that are dominant in the native's primary motivations. Masculine Signs (Aries, Gemini, Leo, Libra, Sagittarius, Aquairus).

Feminine signs (Taurus, Cancer, Virgo, Scorpio, Capricorn, Pisces).

Ascendant is in Leo (Masculine)

Matthew is dominant and active. He is aware of the opportunities in the world. Matthew desires to create his own chance and choose the alternatives himself.

Matthew do what he plans to do and do not change his decisions. He is frank and direct, active and extroverted; he has the willpower to make a choice and to make the final decision.

# QUALITY OF THE SIGN ON THE ASCENDANT

To describe the behaviours of the native and to understand its tendencies, we have to analyse the quality of the sign on Ascendant. It is also better to identify which quality is emphasised in the whole chart. Cardinal Signs: (Aries, Cancer, Libra, Caparicorn). Fixed (Taurus, Leo, Scorpio, Aquarius). Mutable (Gemini, Virgo, Sagittarius, Pisces).

Ascendant is in Leo (Fixed)

Fixed signs are focused to the target but they concentrate more on themselves. They want others to come to them and their motions are centripedal; they think they are the center of the things and they focus on themselves. This is the risky part of fixed signs.

Matthew is patient and enduring. It is quite possible for him to achieve success as he acts in a sound and determined way. He is not fine with changing his environment as he is successful in keeping what he has. He completes his duties on time he promised. Matthew is quite stubborn and is not influenced by others easily. He is also quite decisive about completing what he has made up his mind to do. He is not very tolerant and he does not like risky ventures.

# HOUSE RULERS IN OTHER HOUSES

The houses where the house rulers are placed have great importance both in traditional astrology and modern astrology because the other house where the house ruler is positioned (if the ruler is not in its own house) combines its issues with the issues of the house that this planet rules. House positions of the house rulers give us perfect information on in which area of life (in which house) the ruler attempts to satisfy its needs (if it is in the 2nd house through monetary issues, if it is in the 7th house through relationships, etc).

For instance, the house where the ruler of the 1st house is placed tells us the area that the native focuses on. It tells us about the life and habits of the native. For instance, the house where the ruler of the 2nd house is placed tells us the area of life that the native will earn money and satisfy his financial needs. If the ruler of the 2nd house is in the 7th house, the native earns his living

through his spouse, relationships and partnerships; if it is in the 11th house, he will earn his money by the help of his friends and social circle; if it is in the 9th house, he will make attampts to earn money through journeys, foreigners or higher education.

### Ruler of Asc in 1st house

Matthew tries to realise his primary purposes through his own efforts and actions. His personality, character and capabilities help him his purposes. He has an important advantage to realie his desires in life.

### Ruler of the 2nd House in 2nd house

Matthew may earn his income through his own skills and opportunities without depending on others. Managing his financial opportunities, being financially independent and spending freely is important for him. When supported by the other factors in his chart, he will be able to look after himself financially and stand on his own feet.

### Ruler of 3rd House in 2nd house

Matthew may earn money through his communicative skills, his education, travels and his close circle. He may work with his siblings or may earn money together. He may earn money through writing, publishing, journalism and speaking. Matthew relations with his close circle may contribute to his income.

#### Ruler of 4th House in 12th house

Keeping his family life private is important for Matthew. The death of some people from his family may create some problems in his subconscious and bring him tediousness. Problems and scandals related with his family may expose him to some losses. One of his parents may create some afflictions for him or stay in hospital or prison.

#### Ruler of the 5th House in 3rd house

Matthew has strong knowledge on artistic issues, stock market and sports and others may ask his advice on these issues. He may be successful in expressing himself both written or orally. He may write, train or teach on issues related with children and enjoy it. His children may be successful in their education life and influencive in their social environment.

#### Ruler of 6th House in 10th house

Matthew's higher business sense brings him prestige in his career. He will be recognised as much as he makes efforts. He may work with the people in authority and high level people. His performance at work may be appreciated by the others. His employees and his assistants contribute his success in his career.

#### Ruler of 7th House in 10th house

Matthew's personal relations influence him either positively or negatively. His spouse may have some contributions to his career or he may meet his spouse through his profession. On the other hand, if he spends too much time for his career, he may have some problems in his relationship. His spouse may also be keen on his career or his family. In any case, his spouse has the potential to be successful in his career.

### Ruler of 8th House in 3rd house

Matthew may inherit money together with his siblings or relatives or he may make some profit together. He may make researches on occult, metaphysics and life after death and write articles or books on these issues. If the ruler of the 8th house is a malefic or if it is afflicted, his siblings or close relatives may be prone to dangerous and fatal situations.

#### Ruler of 9th House in 3rd house

Matthew may be a good author, teacher, academician, researcher or publisher. His journeys, relationship with the foreigners, his language skills, his opinions, his education and his researches on philosophy, astrology and spiritual issues expands his life perspective. He may apply and teach the models he learned abroad within his close environment. Foreign countries and journeys are related with his siblings or close relatives.

### Ruler of 10th House in 5th house

Matthew's profession may be in relation with arts and entertainment sector or lodging industry, or with sports, fashion or cosmetics. He may be famous in one of these fields. His love life may affect his prestige.

#### Ruler of 11th House in 2nd house

Earning his money requires socializing. Matthew's biggest profit comes from the supports he gets from his social environment, his friends and the groups, organisations and charities he takes place in. Making good use of money he earned may make a good contribution for his personal investments.

#### Ruler of 12th House in 4th house

Matthew may have some worries corcerning his home and family. Sharing these worries with the members of his family will make him feel comfortable. He may be an introverted native who likes spending time at home. If there are other planets in the 12th and 4th houses, he may be overly introverted and being isolated may damage his psychology.

## Part of Fortune in Taurus:
